MONTHLY FOCUS: Each month we highlight a different mission outreach project/program. For the month of May, our highlighted program is the newly created **Rev. Gary Gard Memorial Scholarship** for Discovery Gardens preschool families.

The **Rev. Gary Gard Memorial Scholarship** supports Discovery Gardens preschoolers whose families have fallen behind in tuition payments due to unforeseen life circumstances. In April, funds supported a young girl who had recently lost her father to suicide, allowing her to continue to attend preschool through the end of the school year and providing her with a safe, secure environment during this difficult time—exactly the kind of situation Rev. Gary Gard would have stepped in to do all he could for.

The goal of future scholarship offerings is to likewise provide a helping hand to families at Discovery Gardens temporarily struggling to cover preschool costs for their child. Your donations assist such families for 1-2 months so that their preschooler's education is not interrupted due to unexpected financial pressures.




TREASURER REPORT
